

Four Seasons at Hereford on 5th December 2015

An excellent result from all the swimmers going from 3rd place last time to 1st place this time. As usual the gala started with relays and the 10 year old boys were the first to win their medley relay with the team of Morgan Havard, Sam Rawlings, Huey Freeman and Cameron Day. The 11 and 12 year old girls followed winning their relays with the teams consisting of Jade Cleal, Lily Brice, Amelia Urry and Zea Levy for the 11's freestyle and Zea and Amelia helping Tamzin Latham and Maya Powell in the 12's medley.

Next was the turn of the 9 year olds 25m freestyle with Scarlett Urry taking first place and Connor Fennell improving his time swimming into 2nd place. Grace Clarke then took 4 sec off her 50m breaststroke coming in 2nd place and Huey Freeman won the boys race. The 11 year olds 50m backstroke saw Amelia Urry take the top spot and Brad Creed improve his time.

The 9 year olds 25m breaststroke saw Grace Clarke win with a new time and Owain Havard improve his breaststroke time before Erlina Ainsworth won her 50m backstroke and freestyle and Zea Levy won her 50m butterfly and breaststroke. Finlay Stuart-Gunter finished in first place in his 50m freestyle with a PB and in the 10 year olds 50m butterfly Erlina improved her time, Huey Freeman sprinted into 1st place and Danny Jones improved his 50m breaststroke time. Improvements in their 25m butterfly time for Broden Powell and Grace Clarke who finished in 1st place with a 4 sec PB and Tamzin Latham improved her 50m backstroke time.

The gala finished with relays and this time it was the turn of the 10 year old girls to shine winning the freestyle relay were Caitlin Day, Izzy Norris, Grace Clarke and Erlina Ainsworth and the 11 and 12 year old girls teams both won their medley and freestyle relays. A splendid finish to the year for the younger swimmers with new talent coming through to join the more experienced swimmers - a great future lies ahead.
